Title – Do not italicize, bold, underline, nor all cap your title

Indent the first line of paragraphs (use the “Tab” key, it is equivalent to five spaces).

Margins should be one inch on all sides. Double-space your paper, and Times New Roman 12 point is a good standard font.

Leave one space after periods and punctuation. Insert a header with page numbers in the top right corner. Use italics for titles in your paper. Do not use contractions or abbreviations. If you have end notes, include them on a separate paper before your works cited page. Title this section “Notes.” See Purdue Owl for further explanation.

MLA Formatting

Notice, the first level of headings should be a different font, placed at the margin, and the first sentence is not indented.

Further subheadings. The next level of heading should be in italics and the paragraph continues directly after the header.

In-text citations. An in-text citation is the first word from the Works Cited entry and page number, if available. Examples include quotes, paraphrases, and signal words.

Wordsworth stated that Romantic poetry was marked by a "spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings" (263). Romantic poetry is characterized by the "spontaneous overflow of powerful feelings" (Wordsworth 263). Wordsworth extensively explored the role of emotion in the creative process (263).
